



NOTICE OF STREET RESURFACING

Lexington County has awarded our company with a contract to resurface your road with slurry seal. This is a thin, cold-applied asphalt overlay that will improve the surface traction and aesthetic appeal of your street. We will endeavor to keep installation inconveniences to a minimum. To help us ensure a quality installation without damage to personal property, please read and follow the guidelines below.

WORK DATES & PARKING:

Work is schedule for the following circled/highlighted day(s) and dates(s). In order to complete the new surface, *all vehicles and other personal property must be removed from the street by 8:00 A.M.*

PLEASE NOTE: In the event of inclement weather or other unforeseen event on the date(s) listed above, we will work on the day following the date listed. *If you have any questions following a delay, please call the project superintendent listed below.*

TRAFFIC CONTROL & DRIVING:

Traffic will be restricted to one lane during paving operations with one lane remaining open for travel.

Cul-de-sac streets will be closed to ensure the fastest installation so alternative parking should be utilized.

Orange cones will mark off work areas and other areas that should not be driven on.

The new pavement needs to cure for approximately 3 hours before it can be opened for traffic. We request that if you must cross over an unopened section of roadway that you wait at least one hour after it has been paved. Cross straight over - do not turn sharply on the new surface or you will damage it. Do not continue to drive on the closed lane. *Failure to follow these guidelines will damage the road and may possibly soil your vehicle and property with asphalt!*

If you have concrete or exposed aggregate driveways, do not cross over the new surface and into your drive until the cones have been removed from the street. This will prevent asphalt from being tracked onto your driveway.

Please ensure that sprinkler systems are turned off during this period.

SAFETY:

For your safety and the safety of our employees, please be aware that when you leave your driveway you may be entering our work zone. Always remember to look both ways before exiting or entering your driveway. If you encounter our employees or equipment, *please slow down and proceed with caution.*
